- Answer frequently asked questions with confidence
- Clearly explain the structure and purpose of the program
- Recommend HP appropriately based on individual family needs
- Determine client eligibility for participation
- Provide continuous support and follow-up
- Address and respond to parental concerns effectively
- Train parents in administering HP
- Build trust and supportive relationships with families

Case Management Skills

- Monitor and manage immune responses
- Interpret client reactions and communicate findings
- Personalize HP programs to suit individual needs
- Assess when referrals are necessary
- Design individualized HP protocols
- Provide educational materials and informed consent documents
- Ensure clients have access to ongoing support and resources

Marketing Skills

- Promote your HP offerings confidently and accurately
- Utilize professional resources to market your program effectively
